1. Membership Fee

Part of the ICC's annual financing requirements are covered by partner contributions (flat-rate annual contributions) from the members.

The partner contribution for 2026 is EUR 1,010.-- (net amount – ICC as non profit organization is not entitled to charge tax).

The partner contribution is valid for the calendar year 2026. According to our statutes, the partnership can be terminated only by the end of each calendar year, providing a written notice at least 3 months prior to the planned termination. As agreed at the General Assembly, a new clause was added to the ICC Statutes stipulating that membership fees are automatically adjusted in line with the Eurozone inflation rate measured over the 12-month period up to and including September of the current year. For 2024, the recorded inflation rate was 2.4%, and for 2025 the overall rate to date is 2%. Accordingly, and in keeping with the estimated total inflation for 2025, the membership fees for 2026 were adjusted by 2%. If the partnership is terminated prematurely due to a decision of the ICC General Assembly, the partner contribution will not be refunded on a pro rata basis.
