


Fusarium Head Blight of the durum wheat [*Triticum turgidum* L. subsp. *durum* (Desf.) Husn.]

6 bread wheat tester



2019-20 cropping season,
Eraclea, northern Italy and
Reggio Calabria, southern
Italy: 16 durum wheat
cultivars + 2 bread wheat
testers

In all three tested
environments only
three cultivars of
durum wheat were
tolerant to FHB
