### 1. Travel

#### FROM THE AIRPORT "LEONARDO DA VINCI"

##### → Train

A direct train leaves the airport (every 30 mins) and connects the airport of Fiumicino to Rome Termini railway station

##### → Taxi

A taxi from Fiumicino Airport to the meeting place should cost approximately Euro 48.

#### FROM THE AIRPORT "G.B. Pastine "

##### → Shuttle Bus

Direct shuttle bus to Rome Termini railway station are available. Serviced is offered by different Companies. The trip takes approximately 60 minutes.

##### → Taxi

A taxi from Ciampino Airport to the meeting place should approximately cost Euro 30.

#### FROM THE STATION "ROMA TERMINI"

##### → Bus

- Exit the station from the Piazza dei Cinquecento side.
- Take the number 40 Express Bus (it leaves every 5 mins) for 3 stops and get off at Piazza Venezia
- Turn left into Piazza SS. Apostoli, walk for 50 m through the square and turn right into Via del Vaccaro, which, after 40 m, leads into Piazza della Pilotta
- The Conference Centre is situated on the upper side of the square, inside the Pontifical Gregorian University

##### → Metro underground trains

- Inside the station, take the Metro A line for 2 stops and get off at BARBERINI-TREVI Station, then walk as described in the "FROM THE METRO" paragraph

##### → On Foot

- Exit the station from the Piazza dei Cinquecento side.
- Continue on in the direction of the adjacent Piazza della Repubblica and turn left into Via Nazionale
- Walk all the way along it for about 500 m as far as Largo Magnanapoli and continue straight on (the name of the road changes and becomes Via IV Novembre)
- Go down Via IV Novembre for 100 m
- Turn right under the arch in Via della Pilotta, which, after 30 m, leads into Piazza della Pilotta



## DIVERFARMING

### FROM THE METRO (UNDERGROUND TRAINS)

- METRO A line ("BARBERINI-TREVI" station)

From this station, walk in the direction of Via del Tritone and, from here, follow the directions to the Trevi Fountain (Fontana of Trevi); once you have reached the Fountain, continue on for 100 m in Via de' Lucchesi, which leads into Piazza della Pilotta (the Conference Centre is on your left): about 800 m.

- METRO B line ("CAVOUR" station)

From this station walk along Via Leonina, turn right into Via del Boschetto and then to your left continue on along Via Panisperna; once you have reached Largo Magnanapoli walk down Via IV Novembre. The first road on the right (under the arch) is Via della Pilotta, which leads into the square of the same name (the Conference Centre is on your right): about 1,200 m.

**Bus and subway tickets should be purchased in advance** and are **available from underground stations, tobacco shops and newspaper kiosks**. Tickets cost **1,5 Euro** and may be used once for metro/subway transport and unlimited bus travel within the ticket validation time of 75 minutes. Tickets should be validated upon entering buses and trams.

**Important: book in advance (right now if you intend to participate)**

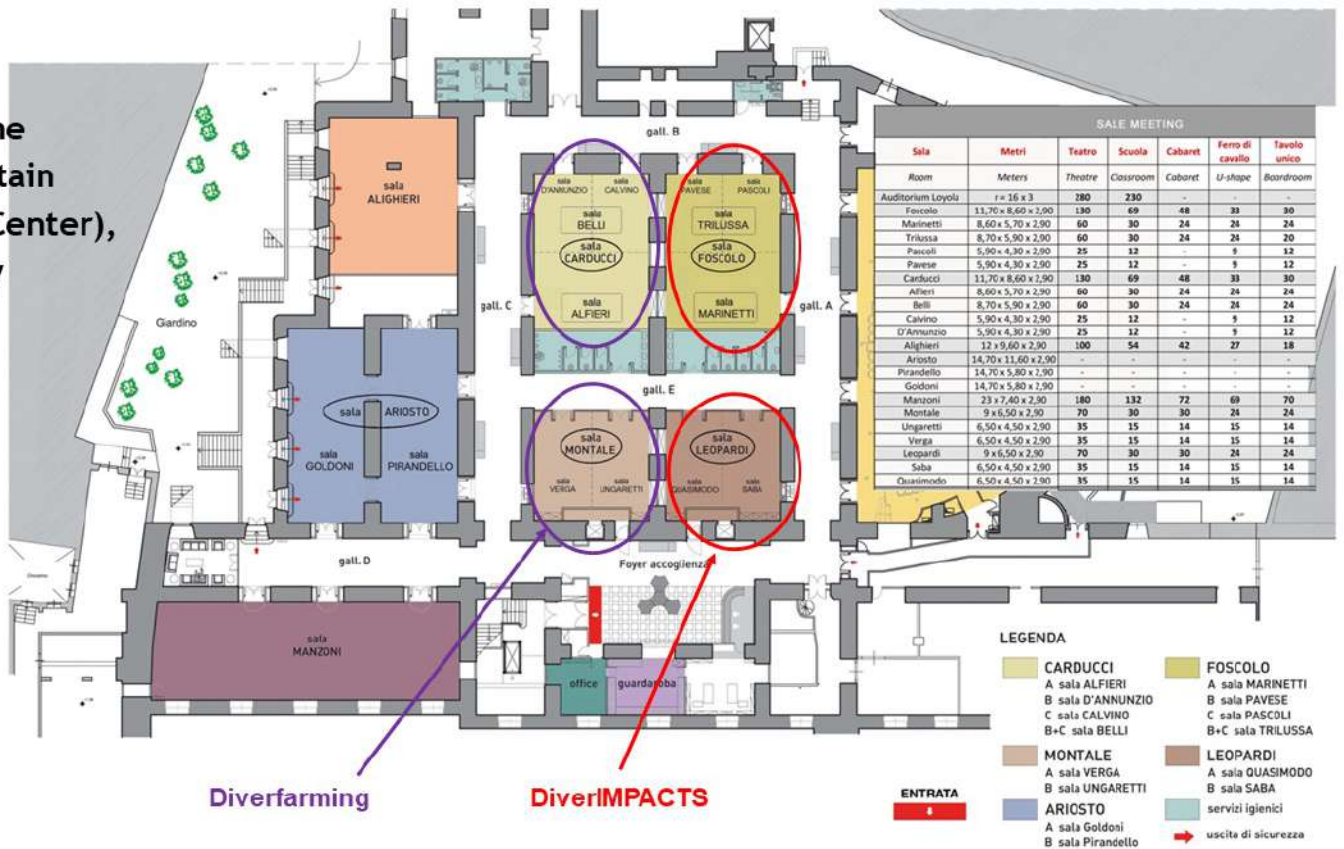
#### **3. Meals**
